Short theoretical lectures and structured videos will guide you through the various steps of surgery in the morning before hands-on training on fresh frozen cadaver specimens (one cadaver head per registered otologist) is available in the afternoon.

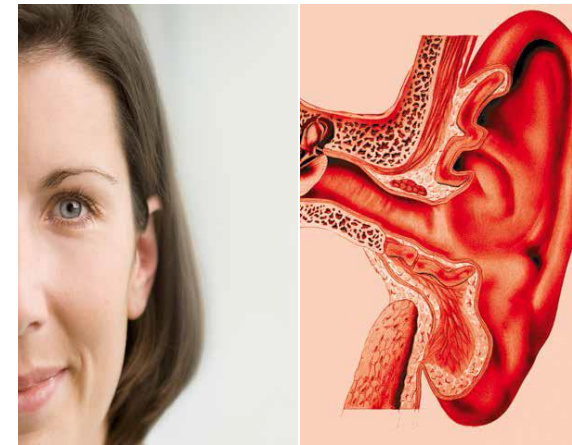
Registrations are based on a first registered first served basis. The course fee (all lunches and course dinner included) is 1.750 euro.
